Project Overview	This project is a student exchange program funded by the Korean Ministry of Education, and is carried out by partner universities in the ASEAN countries
Project Objective	This project cultivates participating students into global logistics, shipping management & business and ocean bioscience experts with Korean and ASEAN cultures
Academic Fields	Marine Biology & Environmental Science : with Chiang Mai University
Study Period	From September 1, 2026 to December 21, 2026 (16 weeks including the final exam period)
Number of Nominees	A maximum of 5 students
Courses to be taken	* KMOU will courses for participating students as follows: For Shipping Management & Business and Accountancy 1) Logistics Management for International Trade(3 credits: 45 lecture hours) 2) Logistics Industry(3 credits: 45 lecture hours) 3) Marine Applied Microbiology Laboratory Course(3 credits: 45 lecture hours) (optional course) 4) Marine Biology(3 credits: 45 lecture hours) (optional course) ** Except Korean language course, all other courses will be provided in English and offline.
Tuition Fee	Participating students' tuition fee at KMOU will be exempted.
Dormitory	Dormitory on-campus will be guaranteed. Its fee will be exempted.
Other fees	Other costs such as meals, living expenses, health insurance will be covered by participating students. * According to the Korean government policy, all international students should join the Korean National Health Insurance. Its fee is about USD 40 monthly.

Qualification for Applicants	1. Applicants should have an excellent academic record at their home university and are of good personality. - GPA must be superior than 2.50 based on 4.50 calculation method. - In the case that transcript cannot be calculated by the method above, comments to prove that the student is excellent enough and equivalent to 2.50 must be described in a letter of recommendation 2. Applicants should have excellent English abilities to take courses in English. - English Requirement : TOEIC 600, TOEFL iBT 61, IELTS 5.0 - In the case that students cannot have an official score above, comments to prove that the student is excellent enough and equivalent to the above score must be described in a letter of recommendation. 3. Those who have a clear purpose and plan for studying in Korea 4. Those who have economical difficulties to study abroad without outside financial help 5. Those who will return to their home university to continue their studies 6. <u>Those who can obtain a study visa(D-2-6, Exchange Student) without fail</u>
Required Documents	1. Application Form 2. Certificate of Enrollment 3. A letter of recommendation from a professor etc. who can evaluate the applicant's personality and ability to study 4. Official transcripts of academic records including such as GAP and ranking. 5. Official score of test of English: TOEIC, TOEFL iBT, IELTS - Its scores obtained earlier than September 2024 are not valid. 6. Copy of Passport in valid 7. Letter of Self-Introduction * All required documents should be written in English only.
